A Message from our Board Chair

The work we do can be heartbreaking and 2023 was no exception. To hear that at least 33 transgender individuals were lost to violence, many of whom were transgender women of color; that over 500 anti-LGBTQ+ bills were introduced around the country; and that NC passed its own laws prohibiting gender-affirming healthcare, sports participation, and classroom discussion of the lived experiences of LGBTQ+ individuals made us sad and angry. But this work also allows us to witness the joy and courage of this community. More people identify as LGBTQ+ than ever, 260,000 people attended Charlotte Pride in August, cities in this state and across the country continue to add their own pride events, and even more community members and allies are standing up and speaking out for equality. Against this backdrop, in 2023 you helped us continue to do what we do best: lead with love! You attended Pride and Purpose, our biggest fundraiser of the year, gathered with PFLAG and corporations at our 2nd annual Corporate Connections, and hosted or attended a Hydration Station Foundation mimosa party to raise money for PFLAG Charlotte and our friends at Charlotte Trans Health.

This support led to some amazing accomplishments. In 2023, we supported more families with new support groups in Union County, two Navigating Your Journey workshops in North Mecklenburg and Charlotte, and three Apoyando con Amor (Leading with Love) workshops for Spanish speakers. We also provided more educational programming for professionals in healthcare, schools, faith communities, and corporations. This work did not go unnoticed as PFLAG Charlotte was named a 2023 Charlottean of the Year by Charlotte Magazine for its advocacy. These accomplishments were possible because of a team led by Karen Graci (she/her), our 1st Executive Director, Lisa Dudzik (she/they), our Community Engagement Manager, Mollie Burkholder (they/them), our Educational Programming Manager, and our interns Asia Ruiz-Smith (she/her) and Persia Mohseni-Tabrizi (she/her). And they were possible because of you: supporters and volunteers who donated your time and money, facilitated support groups, and showed up at community events.

Karen retired in 2023 but the legacy she helped build was recognized as the 2023 Qnotes Person of the Year and Charlotte Pride's Outstanding Ally. With this strong foundation of success, PFLAG's mission continues with our new Executive Director, Ray McKinnon (he/him). Ray understands PFLAG's mission to support the LGBTQ+ community and their families through peer support, education, and advocacy and will help continue this mission in 2024. Ray, his team, and the board will continue to support existing groups, new groups like Apoyando con Amor and a faith and allyship support group, and look to support the intersectional needs of other minoritized communities. We plan to expand educational programming, lean into our advocacy, and increase our visibility digitally, and create new ways to connect with those who need us. This all means more opportunities for you to support and engage in our work.

As allies, it is more important than ever to support the LGBTQ+ community and their families by leaning into our values of bravery, accountability, and growth. Thank you for what you do for PFLAG, for our community, and for your families. Let's celebrate all that you made possible in 2023. And in 2024, let's continue to create a caring, just, and affirming world for LGBTQ+ people and those who love them.




